New Output from Iskul!



Here is a brief financial update of how we spent and what we received in 2017.

Iskul obtained funds from the general public which we called the Friends of Iskul (FoI). The majority of the FoI decides where their fund goes to within the eight critical aspects. Almost half of the donation were specified for the Pondok Iskul's construction (46%) followed by Field Coordinator (23%), General (19%), Students (8%), Mastal Arikik (2%), Iskul Management Team (2%), and Headmistress (1%).

In September 2017, Iskul submitted an application proposal to Mah Sing Foundation to fund the construction of Pondok Iskul. By October 2017, we received confirmation that the proposal has been approved! Iskul is grateful to receive a total of RM 50,000 fund from the Mah Sing Foundation. We immediately kickstarted the purchasing of raw material and construction of Pondok Iskul. It took us more than four months to complete its building followed by another two months to budget and plan for its furnishing. Classes have commenced in the Pondok after its completion in February this year. We are now in the final stage of confirming the furnishing needed for the Pondok.
