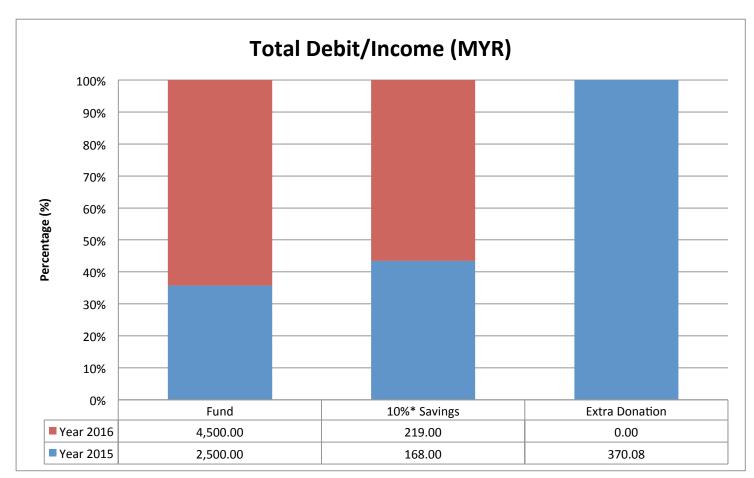
## (A) ISKUL EXPENDITURE SUMMARY FOR MONTHLY OPERATION

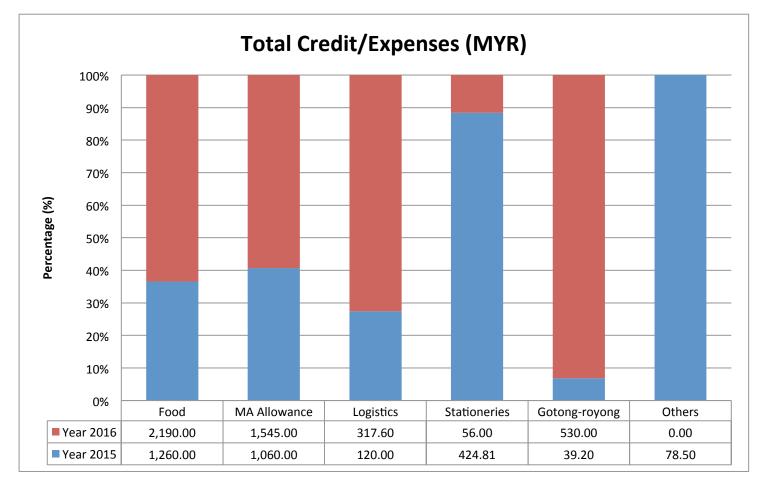
Since Iskul was formed in August 2015, donations from supportive Malaysians and non-Malaysians have been the backbone in sustaining our operation financially. From August 2015 to September 2016, we have spent a total of RM15,373.19. As shown the chart below, the largest percentage of the expenses goes to the expenses for food provided to our students after class at 44% (RM 3,450) followed by allowance provided to our Little Teacher (*Mastal Arikik*) which is 34% (RM 2,605) of our total expenses. Other expenses include necessities during *gotong-royong* held almost every Sunday after class at about 7% (RM569.20) and about 6% for logistics (RM437.60) and stationeries (RM480.81), respectively. There is about 86% reduction in stationeries purchase in 2016 due to high in-kinds contributions from donors. We spent 1% of our funds for other expenses such as community hall rental fee, and reward to students who performed well during mid-year examinations. At the end of the year, we have about 2% balance (not including 10% savings generated) for cash flow needed to continue operation from October 2016 onwards.

With hope that Iskul can be self-sufficient in the future, Iskul adapts an experimental method to kick start a form of sustainable financing mechanism. First, for every food we cater for the students, 10% of the expenses will be donated to Iskul as savings. Initially, *Mastal Arikik* also agreed to donate 10% of their total allowance to Iskul as savings but stopped in November 2015 because they wanted the allowance to support their logistics (boat rides fees) to school. Therefore, most of the 10% savings is generated through food we cater for our student after-class meals.

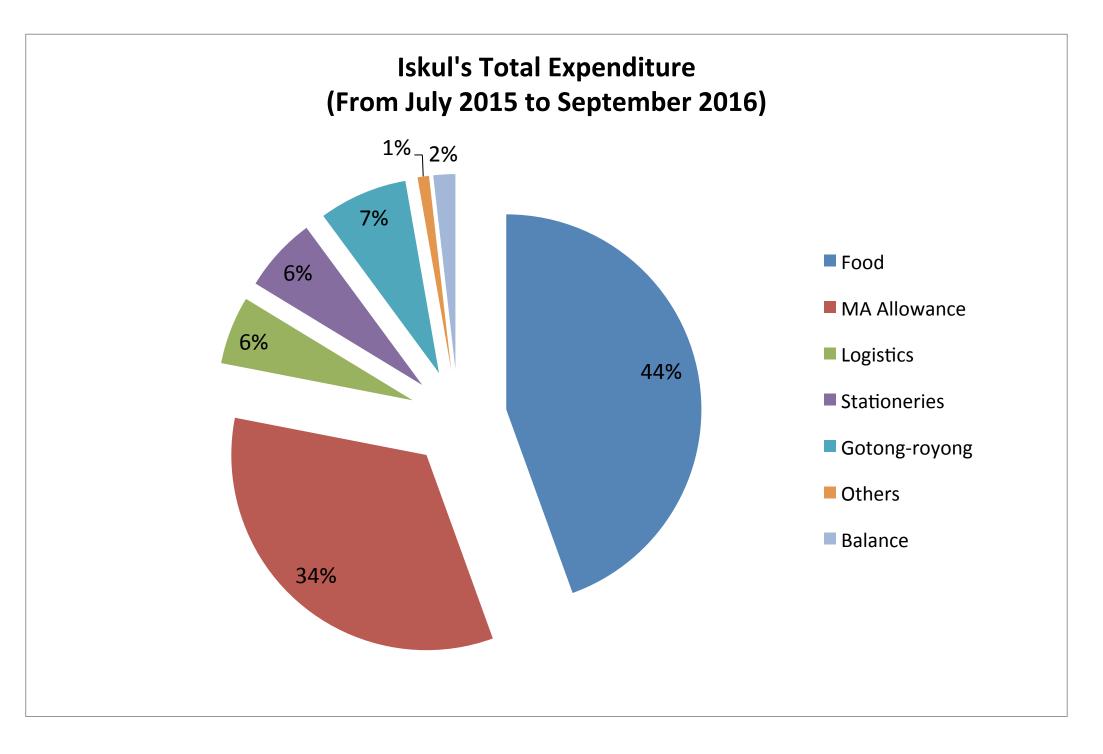
